

HOW TO READ A TEXT AND ANSWER QUESTIONS

BEFORE STARTING: write name, group and alphabetical number

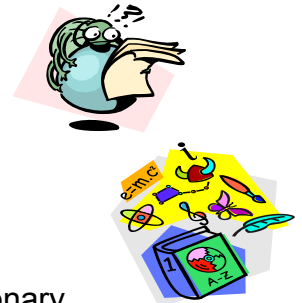
1- read **TITLE** => it usually tells a lot



2- read **QUESTIONS**



3- read **TEXT**, highlight keywords, pay attention to words similar to questions



4- identify some **KEYWORDS** you don't understand and search them in dictionary. Eventually you **SHOULD NOT** have to search one of the "Top 300 most common English words".



5- make **IMAGES** in your mind about the text, summarize it to yourself



6- read again **ONE question at a time**



7- if multiple choices, **ELIMINATE** wrong or foolish choices of answers



8- try to **PREDICT** the answer

9- find **PARTS FROM THE TEXT SUPPORTING YOUR ANSWER**; put the number of the question next to the reading part where you found your answer



10- **SKIP DIFFICULT QUESTIONS** after trying for a short while
